EYFR02B Quick Set-up Guide

Horizontal Key = Programming (flashing blue light)



Pull and reinsert battery, pull trigger to learn the tool

- Hold trigger until you get a green light

If it did not learn:

- ✓ Is the tool off F mode?
 - Has to be in a PS (program setting) 1-30 to learn
- ✓ Is it a Radio Tool?
 - There will be a **R** in the serial # and model #
- ✓ Are you within Range?
 - Must be within 33 feet
- Is the tool stored in another Qualifier?
 - If so remove tool from other Qualifier.

Vertical Key = Ready (solid blue light)



Turn key vertical to use after programming

- Note signal strength
- ✓ Yellow/Green = Very Good
- ✓ Orange = Good
- ✓ Red = Poor
 - Check for machine and electronic interference.
 - Try to achieve a clear line of sight
 - Make sure antenna is clear of obstruction
 - Change RF channel (refer to owners manual)

Connection to Device Programmer Software



Use RS232/DB9 USB adapter for programming

Download device programming software from <u>website</u>.

If it won't connect:

- ✓ Is it on 9600 baud rate?
 - Check USB device driver baud rate on your PC
 - Check baud rate in device programmer
- ✓ Is the correct COM port selected?
 - Check COM port in device programmer
- Read, adjust settings then write
